Tuesday, 19 November 2019

 - o Internal issues for access to money, which has solution, but takes energy and slow downs the progress of the project
 - Yemeni partners need to stay in Cairo for 2-3 weeks to apply for visa. It interrupts their duties, including teaching and research in Yemen. Also, staying in Cairo needs cost of stay.
 - They were not able to get Visa for Paris, which is annoying considering the time they spent in Cairo far from family and work.
 - Questions and challenges related to financial reports.
- Yousef Rezaei from BASU have left the project. There are tasks that have been assigned to him, but no progress. Dr Yousef Aram (Deputy Vice Chancellor in International Affairs) introduced Dr. Hossein Torabzadeh as new contact person. Hossein will take over Yousef Rezaei's responsibilities. New colleagues form BASU will be engaged in the project to speed up developing course materials that should have been done by Yousef Rezaei.
- Course coordinators presented the progress of their courses and discussed practical issues with Yemani (mainly) and Iranian partners.
